RSS Feeds

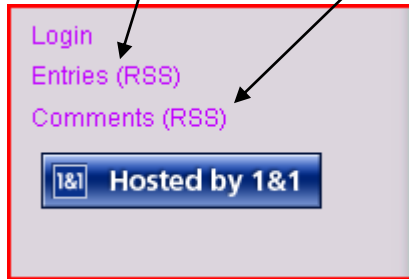
When you subscribe to a site's RSS Feed it proactively sends you information when there is an update.

(so you don't have to revisit the site/blog to check for updates

On Johan's Blog (www.knoxguelph.org) – Go to the Bottom left hand corner of the blog page.

This allows you to obtain information on

a) **New Entries** and/or b) See and add **Comments** made



- Click on the **Entries RSS** to set it up on your PC/Laptop *and later the **Comments RSS**

Your system should ask you to select a "system".

In my case I have already selected **iGoogle** (Vs others listede.g. Yahoo, Technorati etc.)

If you select GOOGLE (there are two option see below – pick one)

The RSS feed will show up in your..... **iGoogle (Your Google Homepage)**
